## KMG Global Crew

From fixers to topside and underwater DoP's, operators and assistants, drone pilots, rope specialists and safety support, the KMG Global Crew directory is a highly detailed and unique system, providing production with specialist crew and fixer suggestions from around the world. ### How it works

Fixers signed up to KMG Global Crew will have a private profile with information relating to their services and experience readily available for KMG only – this is not a publicly accessible directory. When a production company approaches KMG requiring a fixer in a certain location, KMG will forward on contact details to the production company including references, testimonials, and relevant information provided to KMG relating to the shoot. KMG is involved no further, and the production then gets directly in touch with the fixer. Every time a fixer's details are sent to a production, a notification is sent to the fixer that reads only 'Your details have been forwarded to a production company'

### What information KMG Global requires

The KMG Global Crew platform operates on a custom designed app. Subscribed fixers will have a log in with detailed information relating to their services, experience, and skills. Fixers must provide references and testimonials from production companies they have worked with in the past which KMG may contact.

### KMG Global Crew - Call Outs

Where production are looking for something more specific than detailed on Global Crew profiles, KMG may send call-out emails to relevant crew / fixers looking for particular skills / experience. Where crew reply, their details will be passed to the production.
